GRAYMONT PROVIDES PUBLIC ACCESS AND COMMENT PERIOD FOR EASTERN QUARRY TRACT C OPERATING AREA DESIGNATION

Rexton Project | Mackinac County, Michigan

Public comment period: July 17, 2026, through September 22, 2026

Newberry, Michigan — Graymont (MI) LLC is providing public access to the Advance Notice materials for the proposed designation of the Eastern Quarry Tract C Operating Area, located in Hendricks Township, Mackinac County, Michigan, as part of Graymont's multi-phase Rexton Project.

The proposed Tract C Operating Area is approximately 120 acres within Graymont-owned property. A separate approximately 40-acre Preserved Tract C Area is excluded from the operating-area designation and is intended to remain in a natural state and open to the public.

The public consultation is being provided in accordance with the public access and comment process described in Exhibit D of the Addendum to the Land Transaction Agreement between Graymont and the State of Michigan. The public consultation period is intended to provide interested parties an opportunity to review the Advance Notice materials and submit written comments to Graymont before Graymont proceeds with the Designation Notice process.
